Bucks Run Fall League will be a competitive league with a maximum individual handicap of 18 for 9 holes. You must have a USGA handicap or one approved by Bucks Run professional staff. If you have played in a Bucks Run league this year, we will take your average for your handicap.

Cost: \$180.00 per person
9 holes of golf with cart, for 6 weeks - \$150.00
League Prizes- \$30.00

The season will be 6 weeks long, and will run from September 2nd – October 7th

Tee times will be from 5:00-6:04 with 8 minute intervals
Depending on the amount of teams this league will be flighted, playing both front and back nine's

Limited to the first 32 two-man teams that signup
Your \$180 entry fee must be paid in advance to Bucks Run Golf Club,

FORMAT

Nine Holes
One Better Ball of Two
100% handicap w/ a maximum of 18 for 9 holes

Stableford Points

Net Bogey	1 Point
Net Par	2 Points
Net Birdie	3 Points
Net Eagle	4 Points
Net Double Eagle	5 Points

After a net score of double bogey, please pick up in order to facilitate play.

HANDICAPS

All participants shall play to their current handicap including those players that are plus. The 9-hole handicap will be based on 50% of the current 18-hole handicap of the course you are playing. All players will round down to the next lowest stroke for a handicap. This is based on play from the white tees for men and red tees for women on each course. If you do not have a USGA Handicap and played in a Bucks Run league this year, your handicap will be based on the average of your scores.

One Better Ball of Two Stableford Points

This format is in place to make the league a team game and not so much based on individual performance. You will take the better score for your team on each hole, at the end of the round you will add all points received. At the end of the match, the team with the most stableford points will receive one additional point.

TIES

Any overall ties shall be broken with the following tie breaking procedure.

Overall Places

Head to head points the first week. If still tied after this, head to head points the second week and so on until a winner is determined. This will be done for all payout positions.

Player A and Player B are partners. **Player A** has a nine-hole handicap of nine, and **Player B** has a nine-hole handicap of one. On the first hole at Bucks Run **Player A** scored a 5, while **Player B** scored a 5. The first hole is the 17th handicapped hole at Bucks Run, which makes it the 8th handicapped hole for the front nine. **Player A** gets his one shot to make it a Net 4, and **Player B** does not receive any shots so he remains at 5. According to the points allotted **Player A** scored 2 points while **Player B** scores 1.

Now the format One Better Ball of Two indicates that you take the score with the highest amount of points. So on hole 1 at Bucks Run this team scored 2 points, and so on through the rest of the round.

Fall Golf League Rules/By-laws

1. You must have an established USGA handicap of 18 or less for 9 holes (or one approved by the Bucks Run)
2. Handicaps will be flighted by taking ½ of your 18-hole handicap, and combining that with your partner's handicap.
3. Each week the handicaps will be refigured.
4. All alcohol must be purchased from Bucks Run.
5. Proper golf attire is required at all times. For men, collared shirts are required and jeans are allowed as long as they are presentable (not ripped or torn).
6. You may bump the ball in the fairway through the green, everywhere else you must play it down.
7. Play ready golf that is hit when you are ready.
8. Gimmes are allowed; any putt within 3 feet may be conceded. This is not mandatory; a gimme putt is at the discretion of your opponent.
9. USGA Rules will be followed regarding all out-of-bounds and hazards play.
10. All men will play from White Tees, women will play Red Tees
11. If a player is going to be absent, it is his/her responsibility to find a sub from the sub list and notify the opposing team captain at least 24 hours in advance.
12. If you need to reschedule your round, it must be played before the next league night. If you miss your night to play, it will be up to the team to get together and make up the round. You can NOT play on separate nights; you MUST play with your partner.
13. If you don't show up you automatically forfeit the points for that week, you must let your playing competitors know.
14. At the end of the match, the team with the most stableford points will receive one additional point
